





# SYNOPSIS

Alice, in Wonderland, remarks: "Who in the world am I? Ah, that's the great puzzle." This existential conundrum lies at the heart of how the law wrestles with protecting and securing identity online. Using the context of online gaming and the expanding metaverse as a context for the discussion, this panel explores three dimensions for securing identity across physical and digital reality. The panel will dive into an examination of the growing risk of 'identity harms' from identity theft and doxxing, to the use and abuse of burner identities. # SYNOPSIS


